RESOLUTION 1 (Berlin 1)

The TC confirms that the titles of the draft standards shall read as follows :

ISO 24510 Service activities relating to drinking water and wastewater – Guidelines for the improvement and for the assessment of the service to users

ISO 24511 Service activities relating to drinking water and wastewater – Guidelines for the management of wastewater utilities and for the assessment of wastewater services

ISO 24512 Service activities relating to drinking water and wastewater – Guidelines for the management of drinking water utilities and for the assessment of drinking water services

RESOLUTION 2 (Berlin 2)

The TC endorses doc N 251 as the common introduction. Comments from the WGs will have to be returned by WGs convenors to D. Olivier before the 1st of January 2006, after the final WGs reading meetings.

The final document will have to be sent by D. Olivier to the TC secretariat on the 15th of January at the latest.

RESOLUTION 3 (Berlin 3)

The TC asks D. Olivier to prepare a revised version of terms and definitions taking into account comments received during CD enquiries and Berlin TC meeting. This document will be sent to WGs convenors by 1st of November for a final reading at the December WGs meetings. Comments from the WGs will have to be returned by WGs convenors to D. Olivier before the 1st of January 2006.

The final document will have to be sent by D. Olivier to the TC secretariat on the 15th of January at the latest.

The TC agrees to have a single list of all terms that will be used in the three drafts.

RESOLUTION 4 (Berlin 4)

The TC endorses document N 248 (subclauses 7.1, 7.2 and 7.3 on assessment) for WG 3 and 4 drafts. The TC acknowledges the fact that some adaptations are needed for WG 2 draft.

Proposals from the final reading at the December WGs meetings will have to be returned to D. Olivier by the WGs convenors before the 1st of January 2006.

The final documents will have to be sent by D. Olivier to the TC secretariat on the 15th of January at the latest.

RESOLUTION 5 (Berlin 5)

The TC endorses document N 254 REV 1 (subclauses 8.1, 8.2, 8.3 relating to PIs and the annex on confidence grading scheme) as modified in Berlin. This document will be sent to WGs convenors by the 1st of November for a final reading at the WGs December meetings. Comments from the WGs will have to be returned by the WGs convenors to E. Cabrera before the 1st of January 2006.

The final document will have to be sent by E. Cabrera to the TC secretariat on the 15th of January at the latest.

RESOLUTION 6 (Berlin 6)

In order to finalize the drafts that will be submitted to the TC secretariat, the TC notes the following proposals from the WGs convenors :

- a WG 2 meeting will be held in Valencia on November 30th, December 1st and 2nd, 2005
- a WG 3 ad hoc group meeting will be held in Toronto on December 12th, 13th and 14th, 2005
- a WG 4 meeting will be held in Pretoria on December 1st, 2nd and 3rd, 2005

The WGs convenors are requested to send their draft to the TC secretariat (without common parts) on the 15th of January at the latest.

RESOLUTION 7 (Berlin 7)

The TC gives a mandate to the TC chairman to decide to launch the DIS enquiries.

RESOLUTION 8 (Berlin 8)

ISO/TC 224 resolves to introduce the following preliminary work item into its work programme "Guide for the application of ISO 24510, 24511 and 24512 in developing and emerging countries". The status of the ISO document will be decided later.

This PWI is allocated to the ad hoc group developing countries. A report on the progress of this PWI will be made by the convenor of the ad hoc group at the next ISO/TC 224 meetings.

The first step for preparing this guide will be to test the standards in some regions/cities from developing and emerging countries. The second step will be to launch a new work item for this guide on the basis of the outputs of the tests.

RESOLUTION 9 (Berlin 9)

Following up the Marrakech African Water Forum and according to the Rabat TC resolution 14, the TC invites the delegations to mobilize means and financial resources for the performance of application tests of the ISO 24510, 24511 and 24512 in certain areas in developing countries around the world, in order to achieve better and affordable water and wastewater services.

The TC supports the creation of a team outside ISO/TC 224 in order to manage the application of the tests. This team will be lead by the convenor of the ad hoc group developing countries.

RESOLUTION 10 (Berlin 10)

The TC supports the initiative taken by AIDIS and ISO/TC secretariat to hold a topic session on ISO/TC 224 activities during the World Water Forum in Mexico in March 2006. The TC encourages the countries which have already expressed an interest in participating in the forum (Korea, Canada, France, Germany) to confirm as soon as possible their support to the TC secretariat. Other countries are invited to participate.

RESOLUTION 11 (Berlin 11)

Considering the need of Spanish speaking countries to enhance participation within their own countries, the need to increase Latin-American countries involvement in international standardization and being in line with the second key objective of the "ISO Strategic Plan 2005-2010", ISO/TC 224 resolves to open a Spanish Translation Task Force to work on this issue. Argentina has already translated the 3 complete documents in its mirror committee so as to start working.

Spain, AIDIS and Argentina are willing to work on this task force and any other P member or A liaison who will be willing to participate will be welcomed. Natalia Drault, from IRAM, Argentina, will be assuming the leading position of this group.

The TC requests the ISO Council for its agreement for official Spanish versions of ISO 24510, ISO 24511 and ISO 24512 to be published by ISO.

RESOLUTION 12 (Berlin 12)

ISO/TC 224 resolves to hold its next meeting and WGs meetings in Punta Del Este (Uruguay) from November 29th to December, 3rd 2006, and thanks AIDIS for this invitation.
