
Quick Project Overview

Duration:	2 years (11 July 2017- 10 July 2019)
Specific Objective:	Help WGBM from Syrian and host populations in Jordan and Lebanon to be better able to meet their own WASH needs and respond to future shocks and stresses
Locations:	Lebanon: Bekaa, South, Akkar, North, Beirut and Mount Lebanon Governorates Jordan: Mafraq, Irbid, Ajloun and Jerash Governorates

Project Results

Result 1

- Improvement of WASH infrastructures in communities;
- Institutional strengthening of water authorities.

Result 2

- Upgrade of WASH facilities in public institutions;
- Establishment and capacity -building of WASH Committees;
- Hygiene promotion and community awareness raising on water conservation.

Result 3 (Jordan component only)

- WASH rehabilitations and upgrades of targeted households;
- Basic training on maintenance and repair to targeted households;
- Establishment and training of women's plumber clubs.



Project Targets

Result 1

- WASH Infrastructures 21 infrastructural projects, including interventions in boreholes, wastewater networks, water supply pipelines, pumping stations, reservoirs, etc.
- Institutional strengthening 3 water authorities:
 - North Lebanon Water Establishment (NLWE);
 - Bekaa Water Establishment (BWE); 0
 - South Lebanon Water Establishment (SLWE).

Result 2

- Upgrade WASH facilities and capacity-building WASH **committees** – in 23 public institutions:
 - 14 schools;
 - 5 health centres;
 - 4 detention centres.

Result 2: WASH Rehabilitation Targeted Institutions

Result 1: WASH Infrastructures and Institutional strengthening

Achievements:

- 1 small project completed in Tripoli (rehabilitation of stormwater network);
- 17 infrastructural projects approved by the relevant WEs;
- 13 projects designs under Consultant's revision;
- WaterCAD and GIS training of 8 NLWE key staff.

Challenges:

- Delays caused by replacement of Water Establishments' management;
- Coordination between WEs, MoEW and further public authorities (Municipalities, CDR, etc.)



Result 2: Institutions, WASH Committees and Hygiene Promotion

Achievements:


- Start of rehabilitation works in 2 public schools in Nabatiyeh;
- Technical assessment of 63 public health centres and schools in Bekaa Governorate.

Challenges:

- Unstable support by line authorities (MEHE, MoH, WEs);
- Inconsistencies between lists provided by line Ministries and WAAD vulnerability criteria;
- Lengthy approval process from Internal Security Forces to conduct WASH assessments in detention centres;
- Unlikelihood of establishment WASH committees in detention centres.
