








Why are Hawkamaa-EU partners doing Integrated River Basin Management in Lebanon today?

Inclusive and participatory approaches

Concreate and realistic targets that can be tailored to actors' capacity

Advocating and raising awareness on water and climate issues







The Hawkamaa-EU approach



Partner with academia to map pollution hot spots and develop models reflecting the water availability and demand in vulnerable areas and simulate the impacts of future climate and socioeconomic scenarios.



Map the basin actors and their dynamics and organise multi stakeholders consultations to develop a list of priority measures that reflect local concerns.




Advocate for institutional frameworks for RBM and provide technical and financial support to local actors to implement the measures.










Structure of Measures
