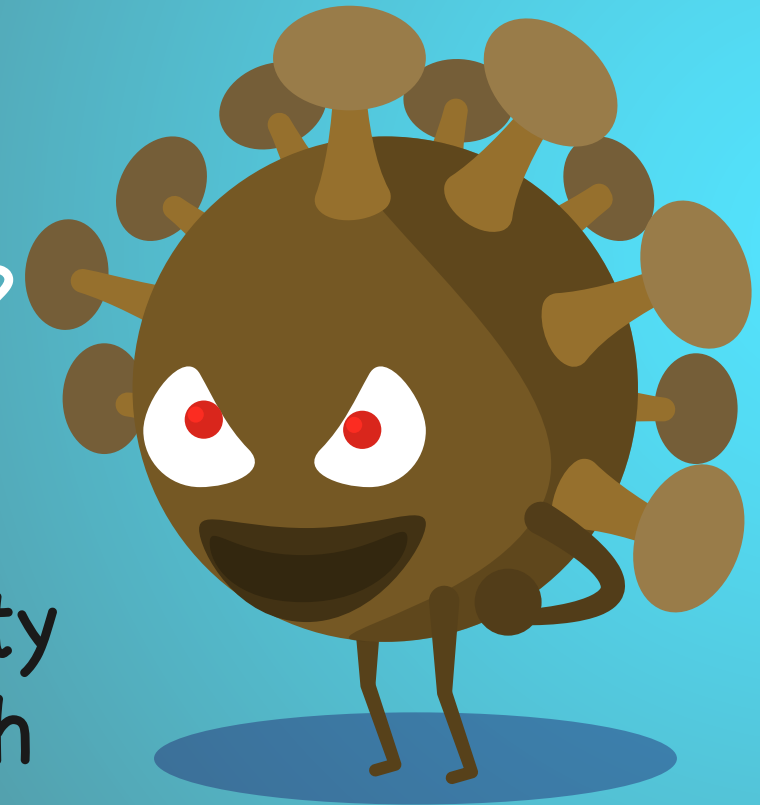

It is so small, you can only see it with a microscope.

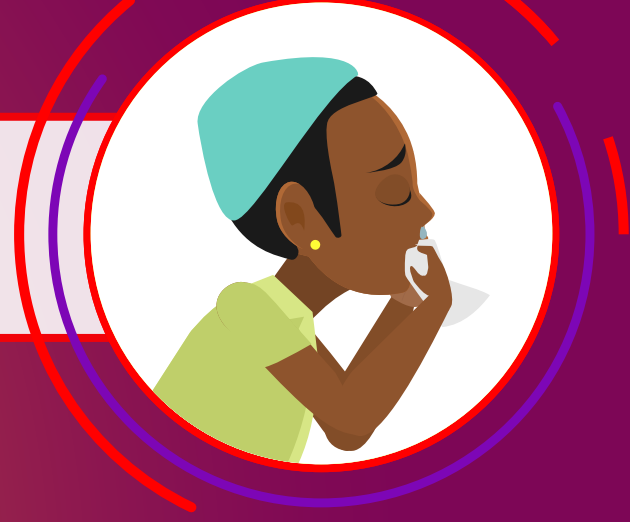


When you are sick

you have fever



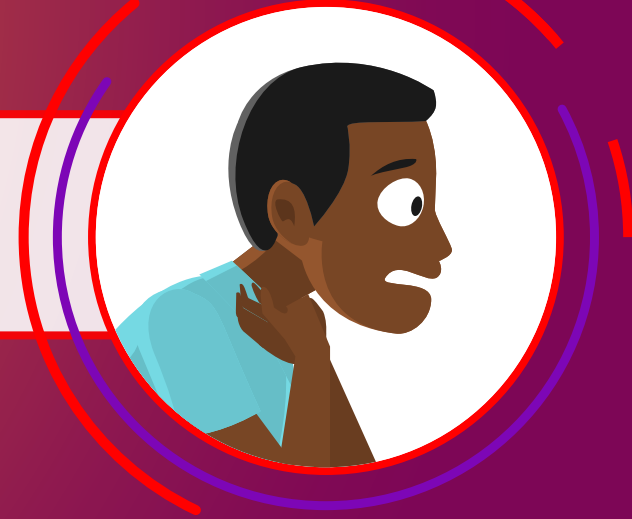

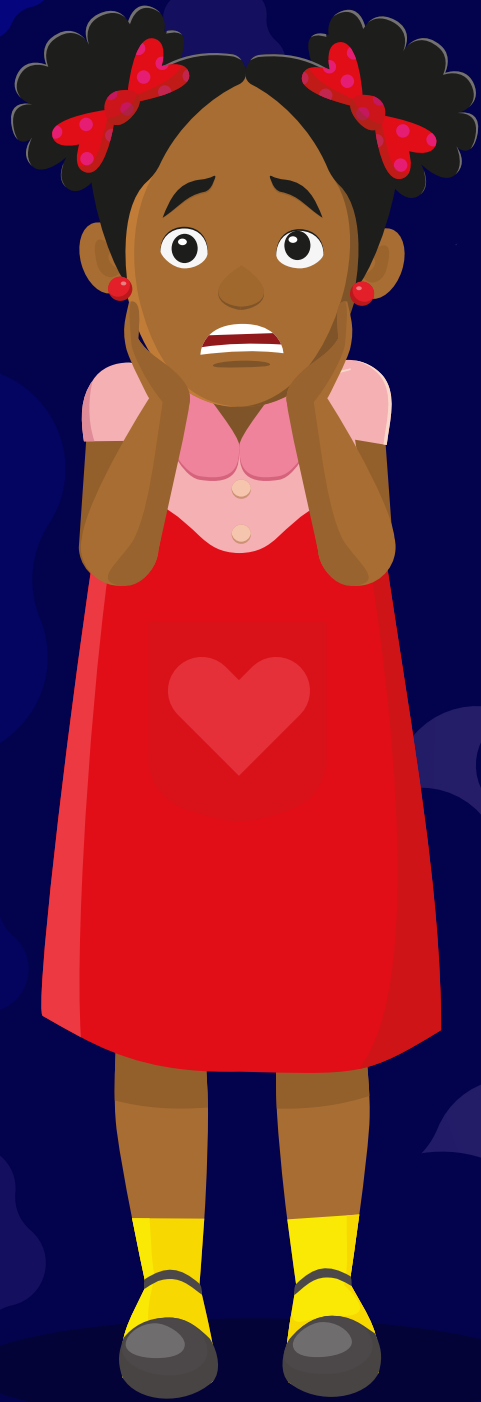

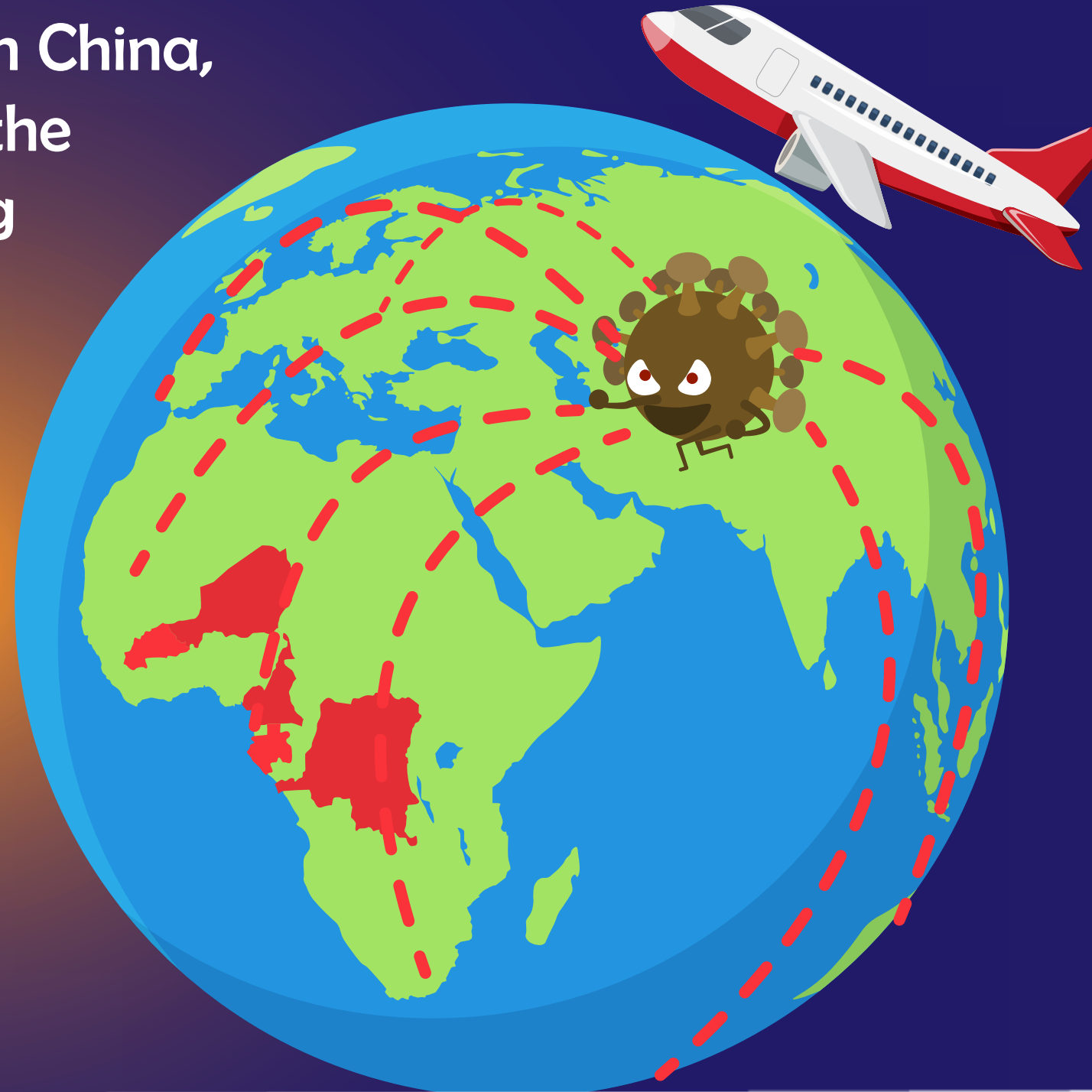


This can be very serious!

This is even cooler!

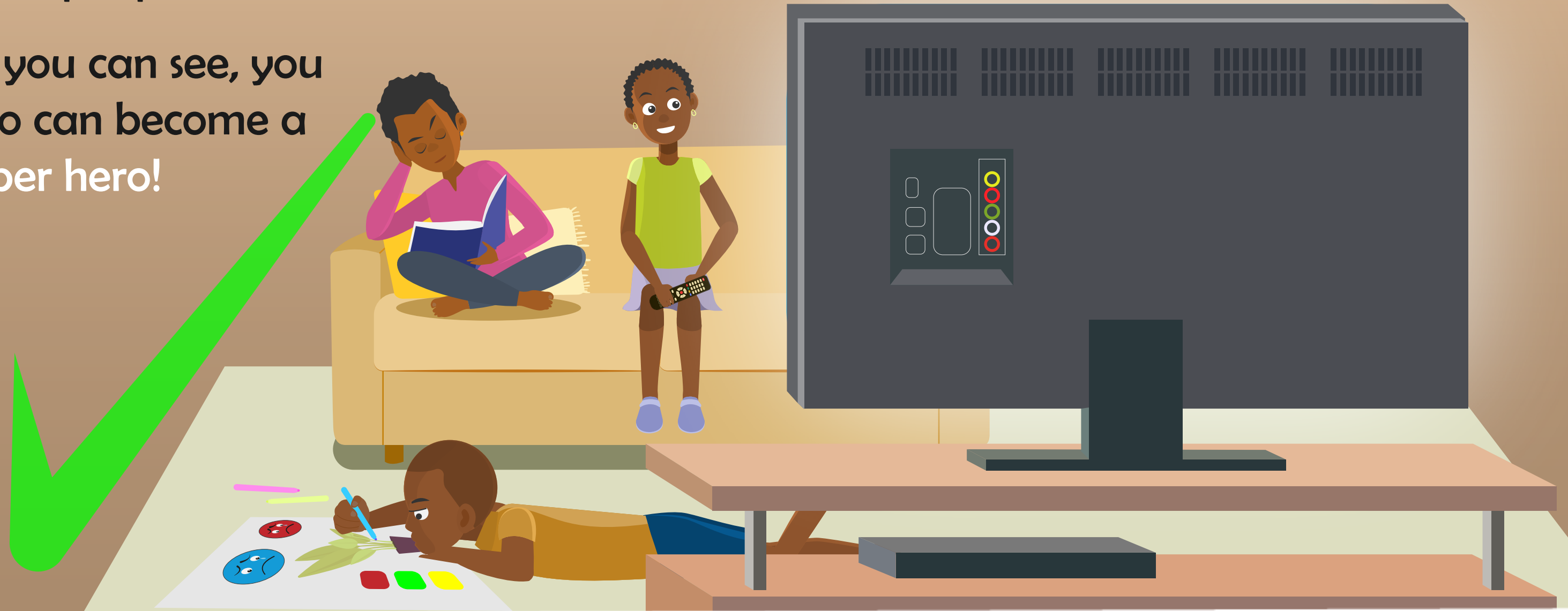




You must avoid being where many people are gathering. Also avoid playing games with other kids in the hood. **Stay at home.**
