




EUROPEAN UNION

In each country of European Union, people give part of their money to their State. Then, all the States in the European Union gather part of this money to reach a big amount. A proportion of this amount is dedicated to other countries, including Sierra Leone.

Illustration: Imagine you give every year a small part of your money to the Paramount Chief. Because everybody gives some money, there is a big amount of money by the end of the year in each Chiefdom. Then, all the Chiefdoms meet to gather this money. The money will be used to help, for instance, people in Liberia or Guinea who don't have a hand pump.

ex: pump officer manpower, spare parts, grease, etc.




