SCHISTOSOMIASIS (BILHARZIA) LIFE-CYCLE

When infected people urinate or defecate in freshwater, the eggs in the urine or faeces hatch.



The eggs hatch releasing miracidia that enter snail tissue.

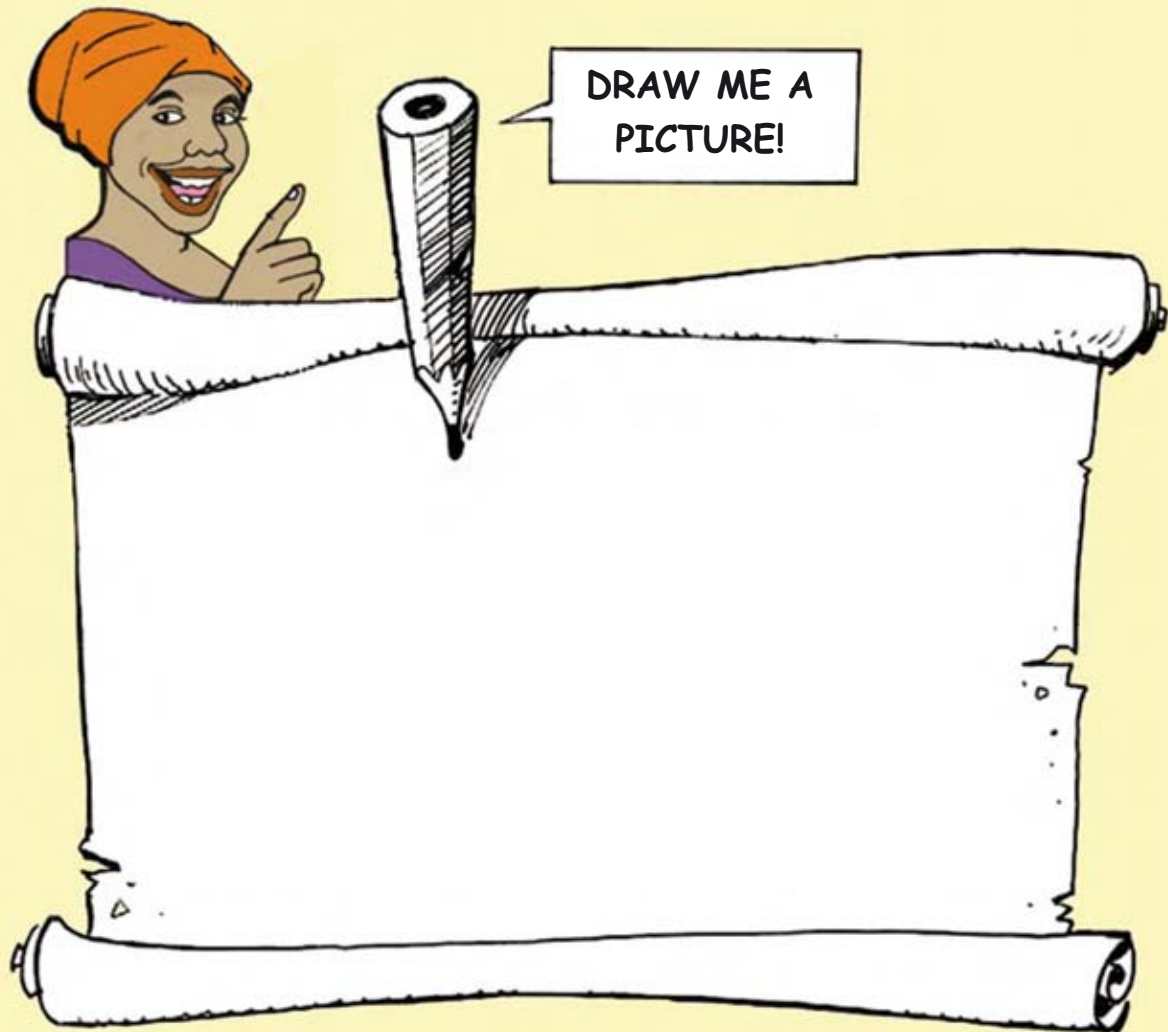


Miracidia grows into worms which are released by snails and swim freely in water.



When people get into contaminated water, the worm penetrates the skin.
