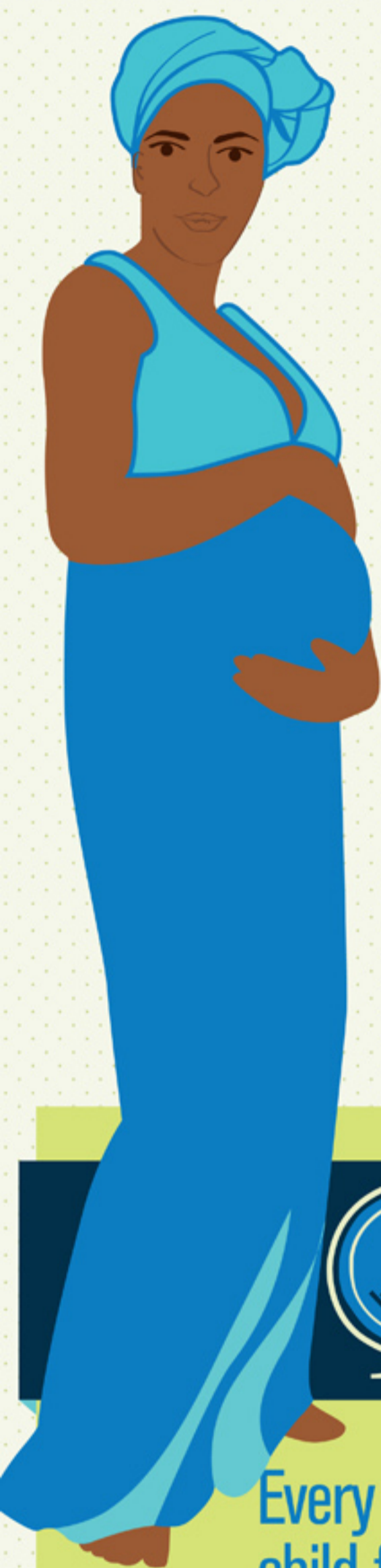
IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES...



She wants education for herself & her daughters



12 million girls in Sub-Saharan Africa may never get the chance to go to school.



She wants protection for her family



Pregnant women and children under 5 are most vulnerable to contracting malaria.

She wants family planning rights



215 million women want, but do not have, access to reproductive healthcare.

She wants a safe pregnancy



Annually, more than 350,000 women die from preventable complications related to pregnancy and birth.



She wants vaccines for her children



Every 20 seconds, a mother loses her child from a vaccine preventable disease.



She wants a clean cookstove to feed her family

Toxic stove smoke kills 2 million yearly, making cooking for her family one of the most dangerous activities for a woman.



She wants access to energy



1.3 billion people live without electricity, over **65%** are women and girls.



She wants access to life saving communication

1.1 billion women have mobile phones, another half billion can only access one by borrowing it.
